DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES

Security Force CRAFTSMAN:

Performs general SF force protection duties, including the use of deadly force, to protect personnel and resources. Leads, manages, supervises, directs and performs SF and force protection duties, including the use of deadly force to protect personnel and resources. Develops plans, policies, procedures, and detailed instructions to implement SF programs. Plans, organizes and schedules SF activities. Provides oversight, guidance, and assistance to commanders regarding application of information, personnel, and industrial security programs. Supervises and trains SF augmentees. Provides on-scene supervision of SF personnel. Inspects and evaluates effectiveness of SF personnel and activities. Protects conventional weapons systems and other resources. Performs Installation Base Defense (IBD) functions, which contribute to the force protection mission. Controls and secures terrain inside and outside military installations. Defends personnel, equipment, and resources from hostile forces. Operates in various field environments, performs individual/team patrol movements both mounted and dismounted tactical drills, battle procedures, convoys, military operations other than war (MOOTW), antiterrorism duties, and other special duties. Operates communications equipment, vehicles, intrusion detection equipment, crew-served weapons, and other special purpose equipment. Applies self-aid buddy care and life saving procedures, as a first responder to accident and disaster scenes. Provide installation entry control, patrol controlled and restricted areas. Maintain internal and circulation controls and prevents unauthorized entry to operational resources. Communicates with security supervisors on a continuous basis. Provides input to supervisors on programs and policies affecting the security of resources assigned or attached to the Portland ANG Base. Operates vehicles, radios and other communication equipment. Applicants will work during periods of inclement weather or other potentially hazardous or emergency situations. Applicants will work rotating shifts and days off. Applicants could be deployed to remote / hostile locations throughout the world.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS: **Qualification in and possession of AFSC 3P071.** Experience in Security Force functions to include: Weaponry, controlling entry into and providing internal control within the installation and restricted areas; response force tactics; air base defense concepts and procedures; terrorist threat response techniques; alarm monitor duties; control center duties; traffic control; and patrolling; has knowledge of directives, programs, policies, and procedures governing Security Force activities; installation security; weapons system and resource security; anti-terrorism; law enforcement and air base defense. Must meet all other requirements of AFMAN 36-2108 for AFSC 3P071.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTRY INTO THE AGR PROGRAM

- Must be a member or eligible to become a member of the Oregon Air National Guard.
- Member will be required to hold a compatible military assignment in the unit they are hired to support.
- Member's military grade will not exceed the maximum military duty grade authorized on the Unit Manning Document (UMD) for the position.
- Member must meet the physical qualifications outlined in AFI 48-123, Medical Examination and Standards, Attachment 2 before being placed on an AGR tour.
- Member must have retainability to complete the tour of military duty.
- Member must not be eligible for, or receiving a federal retirement annuity.
- Member must comply with standards outlined in AFI 36-2905, Fitness Program to be eligible for entry into the AGR program.
- Member must meet all eligibility criteria in ANGI 36-101, The Active Guard/Reserve Program.
- Member must hold required AFSC or be eligible for retraining and meet all eligibility criteria in AFECDA/AFODC

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- AGR members will participate with their unit of assignment during Unit Training Assemblies (UTAs).
- AGR tour lengths in the State of Oregon are governed by TAG-OR Command Policy Memorandum 127
- Initial tours will not exceed 6 years. Follow-on tours will be from 1 to 6 years, per ANGI 36-101
- To be considered for this position you must meet all minimum AFSC requirements to include the minimum ASVAB qualifying score. Scores are reflected on your personnel RIP.
- If your ASVAB score does not meet the minimum required IAW AFMAN 36-2108 Attachment 39, contact your servicing MPF. You have the option to retake the test.
 - You must schedule your test date and receive your new scores prior to the announcement closing date.
- Selectee will be required to participate in the Direct Deposit Electronics Funds Transfer program.
- A law enforcement background check may be required prior to appointment to this position.
 - By submitting a resume or application for this position, you authorize this agency to accomplish the check.

- ❑ Current Report of Individual Personnel (RIP). **Documents must show your ASVAB scores.**
 - RIP can be obtained from the servicing Force Support Squadron (FSS)
 - In lieu of a RIP, applicant may provide a printout from the virtual MPF (vMPF)
 - Select 'Record Review', and then 'Print/View All Pages'
- ❑ Copy of current passing physical fitness assessment. (from AF Portal, <https://www.my.af.mil/>)

ORANG - Air Technicians interested in converting to AGR status:

- ❑ Selection for the advertised position does not constitute acceptance into the AGR program.
- ❑ Once notification of a selection is made, the individual is required to submit a request to change status through their current chain of command and forward to the Joint Forces Headquarters Office, AGR Section.

- ALL APPLICANTS Must FULLY complete SECTION IV - PERSONAL BACKGROUND QUESTIONNAIRE of the NGB FORM 34-1
- Use SECTION V – CONTINUATION/REMARKS to fully explain any "YES" answers, (except 9 & 10)
- A current passing Fit Test will suffice for a "YES" response to question 17
- **FAILURE** to provide this documentation will result in the application not being processed
- **E-Mail is the preferred method of application receipt**
- **Complete application packet should be in a single PDF format document**
- **Limit file size to less than 3MB (1MB or less is ideal)**
- You may paper clip your application, **Do not** staple, bind, tab, or use document protectors
- Submit only single sided copies of all application documents submitted
- Do not fax applications
- Applications mailed in government envelopes will not be accepted
